

Apple Cinnamon Dough

This is not an edible dough ... you will need to use supervision

For a single batch you will need:

Applesauce (1/2 cup)
cinnamon (3/4 - 1 cup)
white glue (2 Tbs)

measuring cups ... measuring spoons ... stirring spoon ... a bowl ... and wax paper.



Add glue to apple sauce and stir until mixed.



Gradually add cinnamon to applesauce and glue mix ... you want to be able to shape dough into a ball. If you add too much cinnamon just add a little more applesauce.



Once dough is stiff enough and you can form a firm ball with it ... take it out of the bowl and place on a sheet of wax paper. Children can use the dough like they would playdough. You can also roll the dough out to about 1/4 thick and use cookie cutters to make different cut-outs. You can then put those cut-outs on a cookie sheet that has been lined with wax paper. Punch a hole in each dough cut-out and let dry for 3-5 days. Make sure to turn them a few times so the other side gets exposed to air. Once dry attach yarn or ribbon. These make wonderful cinnamon smelling ornaments.
