Instructions: Print on cardstock. Give each child a blank story page.... have them draw a story picture in the square (they can also cut and glue pieces of construction paper to make a picture). Have the children tell you what is happening in the picture and write it down below the picture. This is called dictating and allows for the children to develop pre-literacy skills and well as developing self-esteem by becoming an "author". Older children can write their own story below the picture.
