Daily schedules and routines are important in the lives of children because they provide children with a sense of "safety and stability". Schedules will also make your day run smoother and less stressful. When planning a schedule take into account all of the major happenings of the day ... such as arrivals ... me als rest time ... play time ... learnining time etc. It is very important that your schedule allow for flexability ... if an activity goes over in time that's okay... follow the children's lead.

Before I moved it, the children would come up to it and point out actvities to each otfer and say" See so and so where going to do art (teacher directed actvity) after we play (centers).
Creating a picturial scfedules is easy. Youcan use chart paper, (like I did) bulle tin board paper, etc. I
used pictures of my kids, but if youdon't fave any you can cut pictures from magazines or catalogs. I would suggest that you review it with them daily so theyget use to using the schedule and it's best to put it on their eye levelso they can see it and use it when they want. I hope this helps.
