

## Who Took The Leaves And Put Them In A Pile?

Children sit in a circle and and slap their hands on their legs and then clap until they have a good beat going the teacher starts first and name's the first child. The child that is called would then pick the next child and so on until all children have been called. The last child named would then say "I took the leaves and put them in the pile ... now let's jump in!!"

Remind the children that each child is only to be called on once so that everyone has a turn.

Another way to play this song is for everyone to close their eyes and the teacher hides the leaves behind a child's back and the other children repeat the song until the person with the leaves is chosen. The person with the leaves would then place the leaves behind a different child's back.
