Children sit in a circle and and slap their hands on their legs and then clap until they have a good beat going the teacher starts first and name's the first child. The child that is called would then pick the next child and so on until all children have been called. The last child named would then say "I took the shamrock from the leprechaun and it is beautiful!!

Remind the children that each child is only to be called on once so that everyone has a turn.

Another way to play this game is for everyone to close their eyes and the teacher hides a shamrock behind a child's back and the other children repeat the song until the person with the shamrock is chosen. The person with the shamrock would then place the heart shamrock behind a different child's back.
